ABOUT THE JOB:

Job Responsibilities:

- Conduct regular site assessments of small producers in Wild Asia's field project sites.
- Support the development of Wild Asia's technical program focusing on driving sustainable practices amongst small producers. This covers good agricultural practices, social, environmental and legal matters.
- Implementation of technical program at project sites including delivery of training and technical assistance at project sites.
- Regular reporting and communication of project progress to Wild Asia HQ.

Job Requirement:

- Degree or demonstrable experience in related fields such as agronomy, agriculture, social or environmental science.
- Good management and interpersonal skills including experience in project management.
- Able to work and manage work program independently.
- Experience or some knowledge in palm oil cultivation or agronomy would be a bonus.
- Mobile and able to travel or be posted at project site; should have a valid Malaysian driving license.
- Location: Main location is to be based at HQ in KL or at specific Project Sites in Peninsula (Perak/Johor). However must be flexible to be able to travel to other project sites in East Malaysia should the need arise.

Interested candidates are invited to apply with a detailed Curriculum Vitae that should be no more than 2 pages in total and include the following:
